




Prayer for Palm Sunday

Interested in joining the parish golf league? Golf league members will be in the back of church after all Masses on Saturday and Sunday, April 6th and 7th to tell you about the league and an-


swer any questions you may have.

Catholics age 14 and older are to abstain from meat on all Fridays in Lent.




Dear Fr. Mark and Parishioners:
