From the desk of Fr. Ryan:

In today's Gospel, when Jesus was asked if those being saved were many or few. Jesus didn't respond with a number, but with a warning. He taught that being saved is not going to be easy. The door is narrow – many will try to get through and not be able. Jesus said this not to frighten His disciples, but to encourage them; just as a teacher who announces that there will be an exam is not threatening his students but encouraging them to study. Those who feel threatened are the ones who haven't studied.

Jesus is warning those who are complacent that they may find it hard to get through that narrow gate. We live in a time where many believe that all will be saved, regardless of how they have lived their life. I once heard a eulogy in which a son proclaimed that his dad had no time for Church because it conflicted with his regular golf tee-time. So, the son declared, his dad was in Heaven finishing a round of golf and heading to the pub. After a lifetime of ignoring God and His gift of the Church, why would one even want to go to Heaven?! If one doesn't have time for God on earth, why desire to go to a place of intimacy with God for eternity?

“Of that day we know not the time or the hour” (Mt. 24:36). Let's be prepared! Returning to the analogy of the schoolteacher announcing the exam: let's look to our children who are returning to school and be motivated to do the same ourselves. Let us, like them, “crack the books”. We can open the pages of Scripture and good Catholic books to know Jesus better. God has given us Scripture and the Church to know Him and to prepare ourselves for Heaven.

Some of you have asked where I was recently. I too, was being a student. I was on a short workshop with thirty priests. The workshop is part continuing education, part retreat, and part fraternity with priests. It was an excellent time to study and build friendships. But it was also an important time to invest in my priesthood so I can be saved – so I can be a saint. AND, so I can help you be saved – help you be the saint that God calls you to be. I encourage you to be hungry to learn and to invest in your relationship with Christ so that you can be saved – so you can be a saint and help those whom you love become a saint too!

Let us pray for each other. Let us pray for our children returning to school. And let us be motivated by their enthusiasm to learn, to be lifelong learners ourselves.

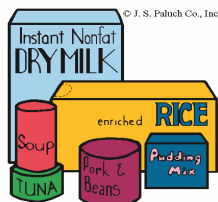

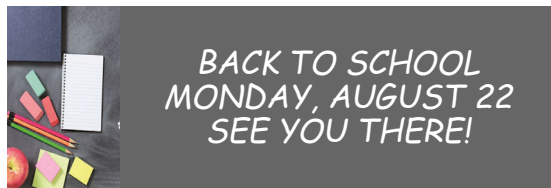

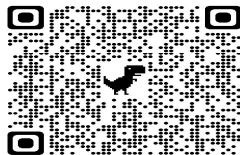
