

The very first step in this process involves **assessing our greatest strengths and opportunities**, and that is where the **Disciple Maker Index (DMI)** comes in! The DMI is an important survey tool that invites you to reflect on your discipleship journey here at Our Lady of the Ridge-St. Linus Parish. The Disciple Maker Index is designed to:

- Invite parishioners to reflect on their own journey of discipleship.
- Enable parish leadership to make data-driven decisions.
- Help parishioners grow in their faith.

The 10-15 minute survey can be accessed through an online link from **February 18th through March 29th** and will ask you to reflect on your own spiritual growth and enable you to provide your perspective on our parish's efforts to help you grow in relationship with Christ. Catholics in good health ages 18 to 59 are required to fast and to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

Fasting consists of eating only one meal, with the possibility of two smaller snacks that do not add up to a single full meal.

Catholics age 14 and older are to abstain from meat on all Fridays in Lent.



From Fr. Mark's Desk:

Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time: "Do not think that I have come to abolish the law or the prophets. I have come not to abolish but to fulfill."

From the Book of Genesis: "When they (Adam and Eve) heard the sound of the Lord God moving about in the garden at the breezy time of the day, the man and his wife hid themselves from the Lord God among the trees of the garden. The Lord God then called to the man and asked him, 'Where are you?' He answered, 'I heard you in the garden, but I was afraid, because I was naked, so I hid myself.' Then he asked, 'Who told you that you were naked?'"

From the beginning of human creation, God had a plan for our relationship with him. That relationship was intended to be ideal when surrounded by the 'cloak' of God's love. When in the garden, that 'cloak' was removed by the first people, they became lost from God, (Where are you?), and 'naked' because they had removed God's cloak of love. The law of God was never intended to be punitive or restrictive. God's law was intended to set in place the boundaries of a fulfilled life in God. Jesus entering time and space is God's desire to replace the cloak of selfishness and sin with the cloak of God's endless love.

The season of Lent becomes an opportunity for us to imagine our lives as God intended before sin became a part of our life.

"These days, I think about the end of life more often than I did back in the day. I can't imagine a sadder way to die than to realize, as you draw your last breath, that you never showed up in this world as yourself, that you spent all those years on this planet hiding out, afraid of who you are, failing to offer the world the most important gift you were born to give, the gift of yourself...The quest of true self, rightly understood, is a journey into relationship, not self-centeredness." (Parker Palmer, Let Your Life Speak)

Allow this Lenten season to be a time for you to recognize your life as God intends it and allow Jesus to fulfill his love in you.
